Unveiling the latest kitchen from celebrated kitchen designer
Charlie Smallbone of Ledbury Studio

Charlie Smallbone, founder of the famous Smallbone of Devizes brand, has recently launched Ledbury Studio, a bespoke new kitchen brand located in London's Notting Hill. The new showroom showcases the debut Metalics Collection, a design that is said to have evolved from the kitchen that Smallbone created for the Chelsea Flower Show last year as part of a collaboration with deVOL kitchens.

Traditional craftsmanship is at the heart of the design, offset quite beautifully against striking contemporary features in innovative materials with shimmering metallic finishes. Elegant and textural, this debut collection combines rustic and cool to create a kitchen of striking contrast. A Georgian-style cockbead detail is paired with modern minimalist brass doorframes to

achieve a unique and iconic look that celebrates a style that transcends trends.

'The copper panels in this project are a work of art in their own right,' says Charlie. 'They are individually aged to give a wonderful texture and dramatic verdigris pattern. Black stained ash cabinetry and timeless marble work surfaces and splashback perfectly showcase the copper.' Glass is another key material, shown here on the display cabinetry that is illuminated from within to enhance the visual appeal and relaxed ambience. Tactile and luxurious, the design displays a beautiful relationship between traditional joinery detail and contemporary boundary-pushing design to achieve a functional yet design-led scheme.
