Metallics have been at the forefront of kitchen trends for a while, but with the **Metallics Collection from Ledbury Studio**, Charlie Smallbone has focused on what he sees as a longer-term trend – metallics with integrity. Smallbone said: "What's important is that the metallics used are not just there for the sake of it or because they add a bit of design edge, but are executed properly. The trend, for me, is metals in the kitchen that look good, have a reason to be there, and will last." The Metallics Collection features real metals including copper, bronze, pewter and zinc. Some are sealed with lacquer so they will stay the same, while others are 'living finishes' that will age and change over time.
