↑ GO FOR GLASS

There's practical kitchen storage, and then there's decorative display cabinetry. A chic, half-way house between concealed and open shelving is incorporating glazing into our kitchen design. This has the effect of breaking up the boxiness and brightening the overall look, especially when it sits in front of a collection of light-reflecting glasses. "For a kitchen to work properly, it's not enough that it should just look beautiful, it must function beautifully as well," says Charlie Smallbone, founder of Ledbury Studio.
