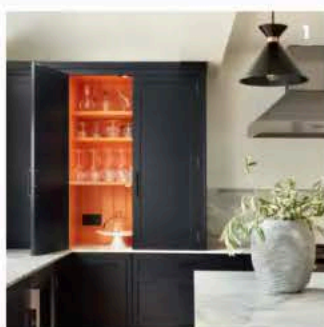

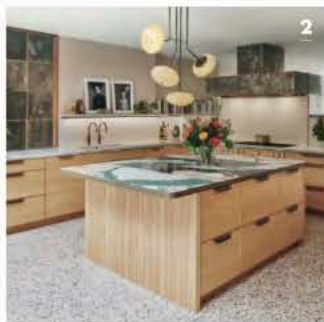
### Harvey Jones [1]

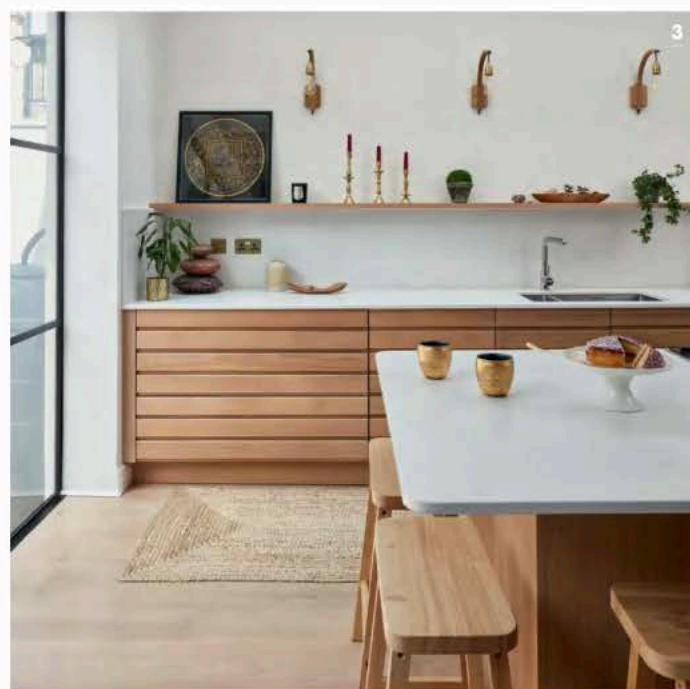
### Ledbury Studio [2]

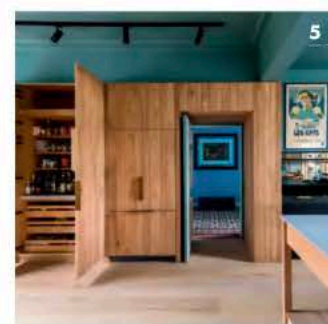
### Inglis Hall [5]

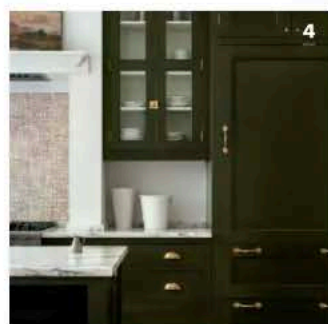
### Arclinea
