Add serious wow factor to your kitchen, bedroom, or bathroom with the new incarnation of the feature wall. We show you how to make this bold feature work in your home and round up the best designs we could find.

The great thing about a mural is it can be made in all shapes, sizes, and designs. So, no matter the dimensions and layout of your space, you can include one in your home. Go all out and install a tropical design in your kitchen to create a statement wall with colours to complement your cabinetry. **The D-Dream mural by Iksel Decorative Arts, from £414.98 per 225 x 90cm panel, creates a feeling of escapism and it works well with the Metallics Collection kitchen design by Ledbury Studio, where kitchens start from £50,000.**



You can add a focal point to your dining room while still keeping a subtle colour scheme. Try the Painterly Palms 350cm x 240cm mural in soft blue, £100, from I Love Wallpaper. Remember: stand-out designs don't have to be full of colour or rich in pattern.



Make washing up more appealing by placing a stunning printed pattern above your splashback. This marble mural in blue and neon orange, from £90, by Nol Moks creates an abstract feel emulating the stone splashback in a graphic way. [Very cool. >](#)
