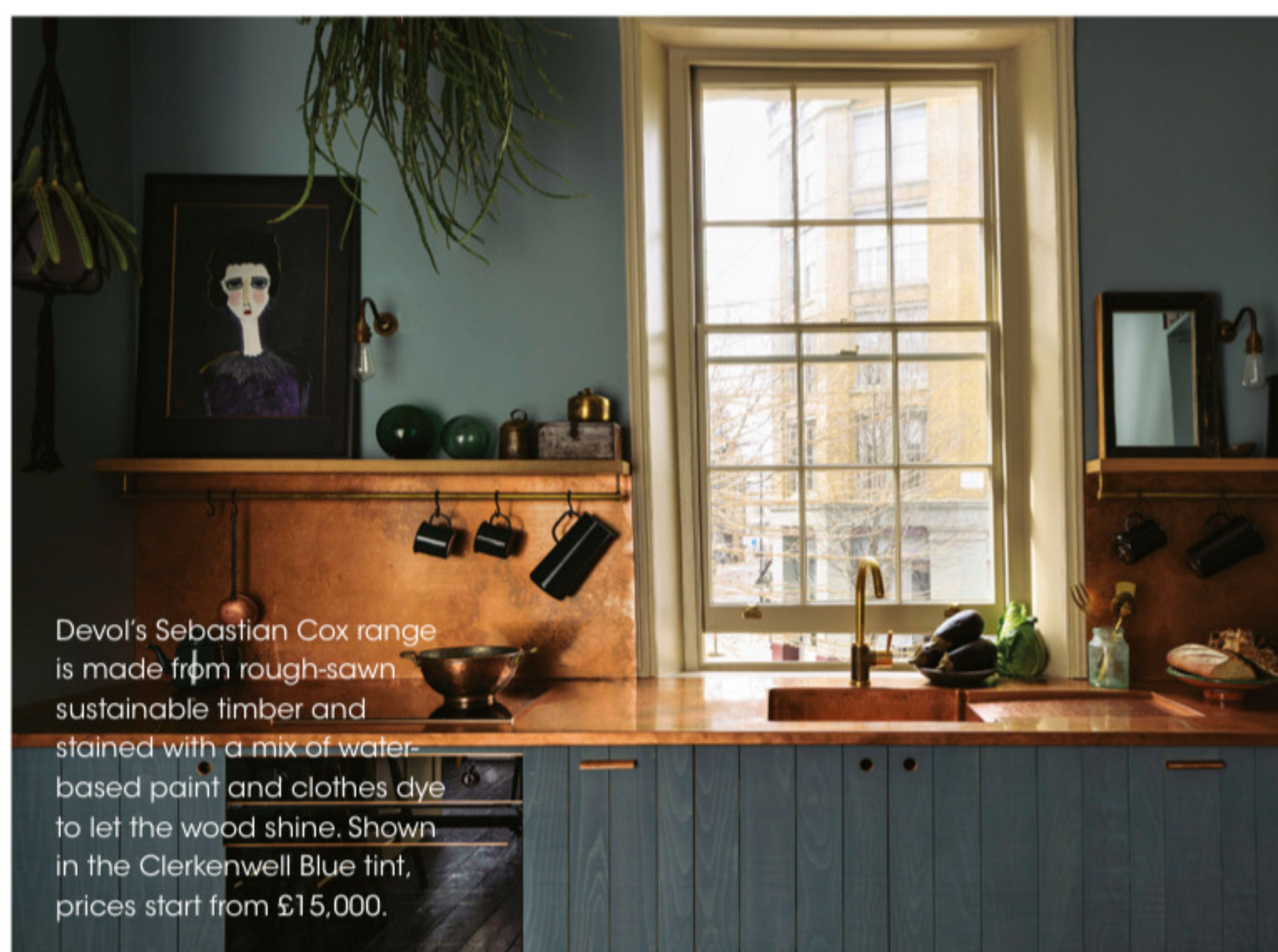

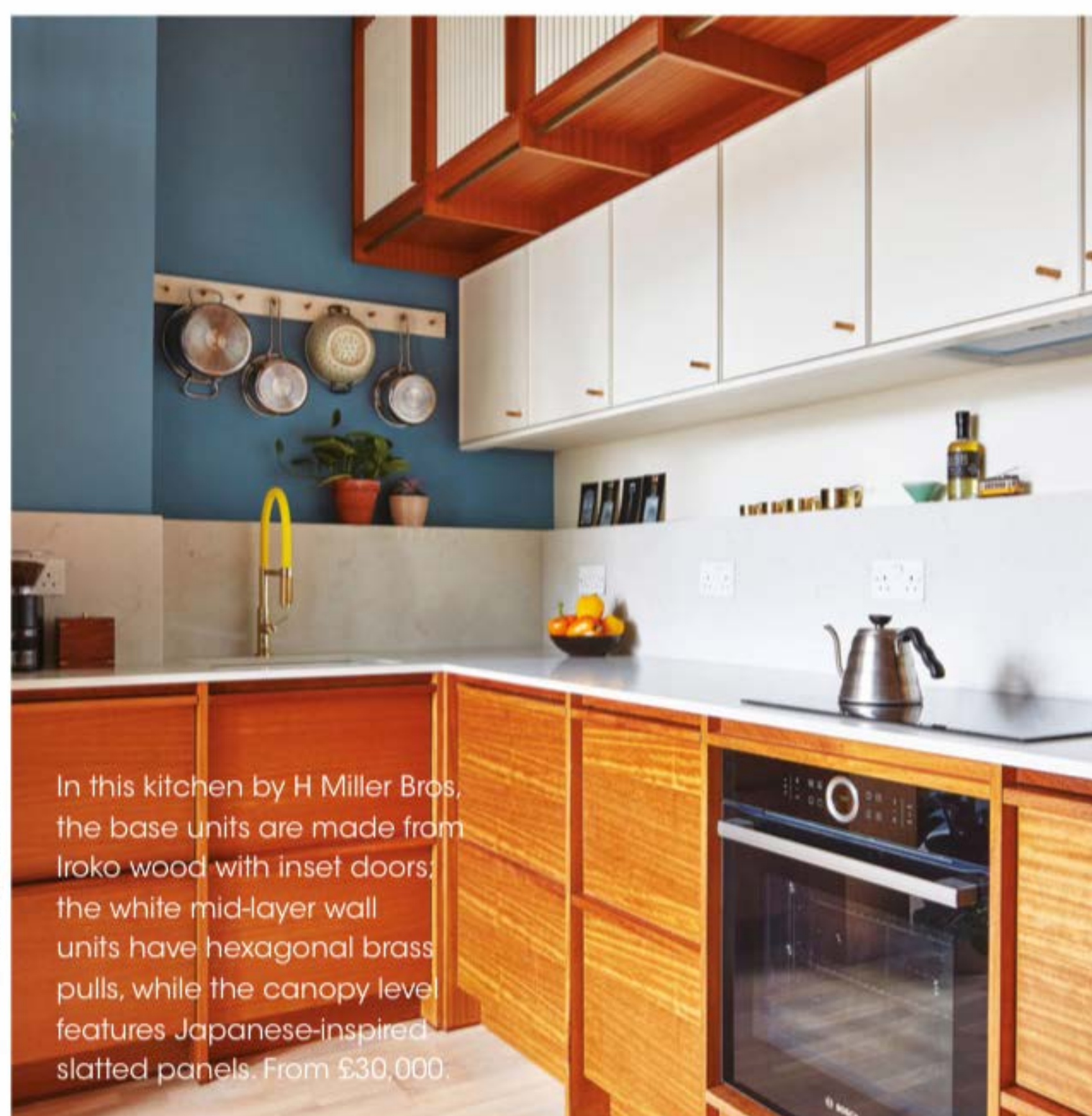
The classics *reimagined*

Shaker, in-frame and traditional joinery kitchens are revisited time and time again for a reason – they as simply won't date. When it comes to investing considerable cash in a new design, it's important your money is spent wisely, so a more traditional scheme may be a good choice. But classical doesn't mean boring or fussy, nor is it limited to period homes. There's an array of versatile Shaker-style and country-look units with a modern twist – think bold colours or pared-back detailing.





Why not choose materials in the same tonal range? Here Marjoram-painted Shaker units are paired with a smoked wood island, while stainless-steel hardware ties the look together. The Butler Collection by Tom Howley, from £20,000.

In this kitchen by H Miller Bros, the base units are made from Iroko wood with inset doors; the white mid-layer wall units have hexagonal brass pulls, while the canopy level features Japanese-inspired slatted panels. From £30,000.
